

Buffalo Championship Rodeo Scholarship

The Buffalo Championship Rodeo Committee will be awarding two \$500 Scholarships to a graduating high school senior or post-secondary student this year. All applicants must meet the qualifications and applications will be reviewed by the rodeo committee. The applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- Applicants should be a resident of the one of the following school districts: Buffalo-Hanover-Montrose, Delano, Maple Lake, Elk River, Monticello, Big Lake, Rockford Dassel Cokato, Watertown- Mayer, Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted, or St. Michael-Albertville.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 2.5 Cumulative Grade Point Average.
- Transcript must be included with application for application to be considered.
- Applicants must have intent to pursue schooling at a Post-Secondary Institution such as a university, college, or vocational institution.
- Applicants should have an appreciation of agriculture and western heritage.

Each applicant is asked to fill out the attached application, submit a transcript and write a 500 word essay using the prompt below:

"Please describe what western heritage means to you and how your own western heritage has affected your life today." OR

"How does the agriculture industry affect our everyday lives and how does agriculture affect the United States.

Applications are due on or before April 30, 2020. Applications, essays and transcripts should be submitted to info@buffalorodeo.com; please include your first and last name and scholarship application in the subject line and have your application submitted as a PDF document; example: "John Smith Scholarship Application". The scholarship will be awarded during the Saturday Night performance of the Buffalo Championship Rodeo, June 27, 2020. Winner will be notified ahead of time and receive 2 complimentary tickets for that night's performance. The winner's scholarship check will be written to the post-secondary institution of their choice to assist in furthering their education during the Fall 2020 semester.
